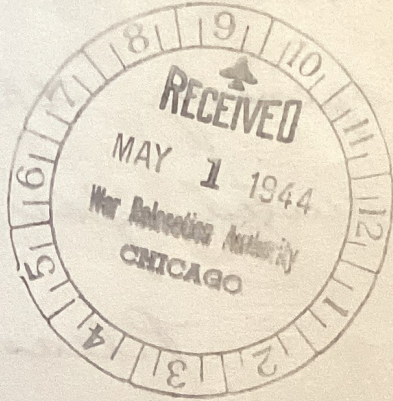
Dear Mr. Kennedy:


